

www.lipoteq.eu Privacy Policy

1. General Information.

The operator of the www.lipoteq.eu Website is **Lipid Systems Sp. z o.o. [limited liability company] with its registered office in Wrocław, ul. Krzemieniecka 48c.**

The Website collects information about its users and their behaviour in the following manner:

- By collecting the information voluntarily entered into forms.
- By storing cookies on the user's terminal equipment.
- Through the collection of web server logs by the company hosting the Lipid Systems Sp. z o.o. website whose address is <http://www.lipoteq.eu>

2. Information in Forms.

The Website collects information provided voluntarily by the user.

Additionally, the Website may record information about connection parameters (timestamp, IP address).

The data provided in forms are not shared with third parties without the user's consent.

The data provided in forms are processed for the purposes related to the function of the form in question, e.g. to process a service request or to respond to a commercial inquiry.

The data provided in forms may be forwarded to entities that provide certain technical services – this applies without limitation to providing information about the holder of the domain being registered to entities that are Internet domain operators.

3. Information about Cookies.

The Website uses cookies.

Cookies are computer data, including without limitation text files, which are stored in the Website User's terminal equipment and are intended for use by the Website. Cookies usually include the name of the website from which they originate, the time for which they are retained in the user's terminal equipment and a unique number.

The entity that places cookies on the Website User's terminal and accesses them is the Website operator.

Cookies are used for the following purposes:

- generating statistics that help understand how Website Users are using its webpages, which makes it possible to improve their structure and content;
- maintaining information on the Website User's session (after logging in) so that the User does not have to re-enter his or her login and password on each page;
- determining the user's profile in order to display tailored content in ad networks, including without limitation the Google Display Network.

The Website uses two main types of cookies: session cookies and persistent cookies. Session cookies are temporary files that are stored in the User's terminal equipment until the User logs out, leaves the Website or turns off the software (the web browser). Persistent cookies are stored in the User's terminal equipment for the time specified in cookie parameters or until they are deleted by the User.

The web browser usually allows the storage of cookies on the User's terminal equipment by default. Website Users may change settings in this respect. The web browser makes it possible to delete cookies. It is also possible to automatically block cookies. For more details, see your web browser's help or documentation. Restricting the use of cookies may affect some of the functionality available on the Website.

Cookies placed on the Website User's terminal equipment may also be used by the advertisers and partners who collaborate with the Website operator. We recommend that you review these companies' privacy policies in order to learn their rules of using cookies for statistical purposes: Google Analytics Privacy Policy.

Cookies may be used by ad networks, including without limitation the Google Display Network, to display ads that are tailored to the manner in which the user uses the Website. To this purpose, they may store information on the user's navigation path or the time spent browsing a given page.

As concerns information on user preferences collected by the Google Display Network, the user can review and edit the information obtained from cookies using the following tool: <https://www.google.com/ads/preferences/>

4. Server Logs.

Information about certain user behaviour is logged in the server layer. These data are used solely for website administration purposes and to ensure the most efficient operation of the hosting services provided.

The resources browsed are identified by their URLs. Moreover, the following data may be recorded:

- query receipt time;
- reply sending time;
- client station name – identified via the HTTP protocol;

- information on the errors that occurred during the HTTP transaction;
- the URL of the page the user previously visited (referrer link) – where the Website was visited by clicking a link;
- information about the user's browser;
- IP address information.

The above data are not associated with any specific persons who browse webpages.

The above data are only used for server administration purposes.

5. Data Sharing.

Data may only be shared with third parties within legally permissible limits.

Personally identifiable information is only provided with the consent of the person in question.

The operator may be obliged to provide the information collected by the Website to competent authorities following lawful requests, to the extent stated in the request.

6. Managing cookies – how to grant and revoke consent in practice?

If the user does not wish to receive cookies, he or she may change his or her browser settings. It should be noted that disabling those cookies that are required for the purposes of authentication, security or the maintenance of user preferences may hinder the use of webpages or even, in extreme cases, prevent their use.
